

Boneo Water Recycling Plant

Work continues to progress for the Boneo Water Recycling Plant upgrade. A smaller team is working on site with a focus on mechanical and electrical works and commissioning the new Plant operations.

Project update - March to May

The main works undertaken over the last three months include:

- Completion of the Inlet and Primary Sludge Treatment Plant mechanical and electrical works.
- Installation of the new odour control system.

The Plant listed above are now undergoing commissioning activities.

Upcoming works

During June the project team plans to carry out the migration of influent to the new inlet works and decommission the existing inlet. The final stage of works on pavements and roads within the Plant will commence.

The majority of works over the coming months will involve work inside the new Plant (mechanical and electrical works) and commissioning activities. The level of activity will result in a similar experience for our neighbours to the last three months

Works are expected to be completed in late 2021, which includes site sheds and offices removed offsite and areas disrupted by the construction activities reinstated.
