

Boneo Water Recycling Plant

Project update- September 2020

This month the team continued works including pipework, coating tanks and completing concrete works. The majority of structures are complete so works now move to mechanical and electrical fit out of the buildings and tanks. This will be the main activity during September so progress will be less obvious to outside view.

You may notice a drone flying over the Plant. The appropriate licences are in place and the drone only flies over South East Water land.

After hours works

Out of hours works are required in September including:

- In early in September work will take place on the weekend inside the new administration building.
- On Wednesday 9 September works will start at approximately 4am and finish at 9pm to install new penstocks. Work will be located in the middle of the Plant.
- During the week in mid-September work will start at 3am to remove a weir plate from a channel near the south west area of the Plant. Notification will be provided when the exact date is confirmed.
- On Wednesday 30 September a shutdown is planned for between 3am and 6am for electrical works inside an existing building.
